Fee Refund Policy for Session 2026-27 **(For all UG/PG Programmes offered by the institute)**

First Year (New Admissions)

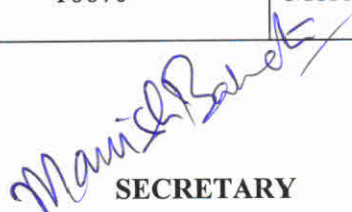
The Management of the Institute has decided the Fee Refund Policy for I year new admission applicable w.e.f. from July 1, 2026 as follows:

If the student withdraws the admission during the period of online counseling, the fee may be refunded as per the AICTE norms for BBA/BCA/MCA/MBA Programmes.

If the student withdraws the admission during the period of online counseling, the fee may be refunded as per the UGC Norms for B.Sc./M.Sc. Programmes. As per the guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC) vide D.O. No. F.2-71/2022 (CPP-II) (C-114546) dated 12 June 2024, in the event that a student withdraws from the program of study in which he/she is enrolled, the Institute shall adhere to the prescribed four-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees	Deduction of Processing Charges applicable on Annual fee (Not on deposited Amount)	Time Period for Submission of Withdrawal Request
(1)	100%	Maximum of Rs.1000/-	15 days or more before the last date of admission
(2)	90%	10%	Less than 15 days before the last date of admission
(3)	80%	20%	Within 15 days after the last date of admission
(4)	50%	50%	More than 15 days but within 30 days after the last date of admission
(5)	0% (No Refund)	100%	More than 30 days after the last date of admission

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Note:

1. In cases where 100% refund is applicable, a maximum processing fee of Rs.1,000/- will be deducted.
2. Processing charges are calculated on the annual fee and not on the amount deposited. If the deposited amount is less than the required amount, the candidate must pay the remaining balance.
3. Students seeking cancellation of admission must submit a duly signed handwritten application, endorsed by the student and/or their parent or guardian, to the Admission Department within the prescribed deadline. Requests made via telephone, email, or verbal communication will not be considered valid unless supported by a formal written application.
4. The effective date of cancellation shall be the date on which the written application is officially received by the Institute.
5. **The Institute reserves the right to revise or amend this policy in accordance with any subsequent notifications or directives issued by the University Grants Commission or other competent regulatory authorities.**
