The statue of unity

The "Statue of Unity" is an iconic 182 m (597 ft) tall landmark. Statue dedicated to the India's first Home Minister of Independent India Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel (1875-1950), a visionary leader and statesman. He is hailed as the Iron Man of India due to his pivotal role in the country's struggle for independence and subsequent integration. He was an Indian barrister and statesman, a senior leader of the Indian National Congress and founding father of the Republic of India. Under his shed we take our independence back from British government. The "Statue of Unity" is a monument dedicated to Patel for whatsoever he did for nation's indep ndence. This statue is located in the Indian State of Gujarat facing the Narmada dam, 3.2 K.M. away from Sadhu Bet near Vadodara. At the height of 182 m (597 ft), it is the world's tallest statue, exceeding the spring temple Buddha by 54 meters. This statue and related structures are spread over 2000 square meter and are surrounded by an artificial lake spread across 12 KM and cost an estimated 29.8 billion rupee. It was first announced the project to commemorate Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel on 7 October 2010 and after 8 years he himself inaugurated Patel's Statue as an Indian Prime Minister on 31 October 2018, the 143th anniversary of Patel's birth.
