Competitions




BUSINESS PLAN COMPETITION

The webinar was coordinated by Dr. Jitendra Jain and conducted by Ms. Ruchira Muchhal.




Webinar on "Job Opportunities & Challenges Post COVID-19"

MY EXPERIENCE IN LOCKDOWN PERIOD


