The guest speaker on the first day was Dr. Rishina Natu, Principal, Kasturbagram Rural Institute, Indore who introduced the concept of 'Brahm' and discussed the mathematical significance of zero and ancient numerical systems derived from Vedic knowledge. The second day the session was taken by Dr. Mithila Prasad Tripathi, Renowned
