He discussed the Yerkes-Dodson Law and the Inverted U Model, explaining how an optimal level of stress can enhance performance, while too little or excessive stress may lead to decreased efficiency and adverse outcomes. He discussed four major sources of stress commonly experienced by students like academic stress, social stress, family stress and digital stress. The session proved to be highly informative and impactful, as it not only enhanced students' awareness about mental health but also equipped them with practical insights to manage stress effectively. AI Meets Academia

SVIMS Empowers Faculty for the Future of Teaching and Research



The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), in collaboration with the Department of Management (PG), successfully organized a Faculty Capacity Building Program on “AI-Enabled Teaching and Research” on March 26, 2026.

The resource person for the program, Dr. Prakash Singh, Professor, Saudi Electronic University, Riyadh, shared valuable insights on the transformative role of Artificial Intelligence in higher education. He highlighted the growing significance of AI in teaching, research, and knowledge creation while emphasizing the need for educators to embrace the philosophy of “Learn, Unlearn, and Relearn” advocated by the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

The sessions covered a wide range of topics, including applications of

AI in everyday life, AI-assisted teaching methodologies, systematic literature review, research topic formulation, academic writing, and strategies for publishing in high-impact journals. Faculty members were introduced to innovative AI-powered and research-support tools such as Mentimeter, Kahoot, Bamboozle, Mendeley, Research Rabbit, Connected Papers, Litmaps, Elicit, Scispace, and Consensus.

A major highlight of the program was the hands-on exposure to interactive teaching and research tools, enabling participants to explore practical applications of AI in classrooms and scholarly work. SVIMS Team Wins First Prize at Jaipuria Hackathon
