Most of the students participated in the survey are satisfied with the teaching- learning process adopted by the Institute. Some of the suggestions provided by the participants to improve the process are mentioned as follows:

- Teaching can be made a blend of graphics and audio-visual pictures based on certain examples in addition to present mode of delivery. Students feel more comfortable with white board learning for the numerical subjects.
- 2. Teachers should give the overview of the topics covered in previous semesters to refresh the recollection of some concepts. More focus on overall development should be given.

- 3. Internships, freelancing programs and industrial visits should be provided to the students more frequently. The sports time should be extended. Support the student to progress in sports, so that the name of college can be further increased in sports too.
- 4. Institute may offer short term courses of computer languages with certificates or add some sessions on psychology or philosophy. Extra classes are required to encourage the students for participation in debates and improve over English speaking & writing skills and communication skills.
- Additional study material in the form of reference reading can be provided to the students e.g. e-books and other learning material. Frequent activities should be conducted so that the class becomes more happening.
- 6. Teachers may develop a connect with students and provide collaboration and socialization opportunity. Students' engagement in assignments and project work that have a clear connection to learning outcomes should be focussed as against providing the assignments for the sake of keeping them busy.
- 7. Mentoring activity are being conducted in the Institute which needs to focus on moral boosting, participation in events and courage good study or perform better. Teachers are also requested to talk to the students about their life and teach them life skills.
- 8. Curriculum needs to be revised as according to the industry needs. Teacher should guide students for their future career prospects and also suggest various options available in the respective fields.
