- No changes in the paper title, abstract, authorship, nor submitted document can occur after the submission deadline.

Formatting Rules

- The abstracts should not exceed 300 words and must be in 12 point font size, Times New Roman font on MS Word with 1.5 line spacing along with the name(s) and address of the author(s), affiliation, contact details & e-mail id.
- Full length paper should not exceed 2500 words (Maximum 10 pages) excluding Tables, illustrations, charts, figures etc.
